Policy on the commitment to ethical consideration in teaching of medical students

Aim: to implement and enhance the right ethical practices while teaching medical students to become role models for them

Scope: encompasses ethical practices in **all dealings (learning and interaction with patients)** with students within and outside the classroom. Thus, promoting the opportunities of experiential learning for the students.

Policy statement:

The management at QMCK will inculcate **and expect** a culture of ethical practices among all the members of the faculty, management, and staff.

Policy Objective:

To practice true ethical behavior when dealing with the students within or outside the classroom environment.

Ethical Practices will include the main principles as follows:

Honesty:

The teaching faculty will maintain a high level of honesty with students in every matter about teaching and learning, as well as in all other matters within the institution's learning environment.

Integrity:

Faculty is bound to show behavior of integrity to be a role model to the students. Faculty must observe the norms of the local culture while dealing with the female students.

Transparency:

Faculty must show transparency in all matters related to teaching, assessment, grading, etc., as well as while dealing with the students during extracurricular activities where selection, scoring, auditioning, etc., are involved.

Autonomy:

Faculty must give the right of autonomy to the students in matters within the learning environment that involve participation in extra-curricular activities, student body formulation, and selecting class representatives.

Confidentiality:

Faculty must practice confidentiality in all matters that involve the confidentiality of any private matter of the students, results, assessments, counselling sessions, etc.

Justice:

Faculty must *practice* (**demonstrate**) justice (**towards**) *with* the students while dealing **with** matters of assessment, selection for specific posts in class/ societies. There must not be any **implicit or explicit** bias on the part of the faculty **towards certain group of students**.
