Health Policy for Students

Queens Medical College (QMC) values the health and safety of its students and acknowledge the importance of healthcare guidelines in ensuring a safe environment. Adherence to the following policies is essential for maintaining a healthy and safe environment for both the students and the community:

1. Medical Examination

On admission complete medical examination which includes CBC, Xray Chest and screening of Hepatitis B, C and HIV must be done.

2. Hospital Registration

Upon admission, all students are requiring to complete registration with Bhatti International teaching hospital or Ihsan Mumtaz hospital Lahore within the first week or shortly thereafter. Roll number of each student will consider hospital registration number as well.

3. Medical Checkup and Immunization

All students must undergo a comprehensive medical checkup and complete necessary immunizations prior to direct interaction with patients to ensure the safety of both the students and patients.

4. Health Emergencies Protocol

Students are directed to proceed immediately to the emergency room (ER) in the event of a health emergency, at Bhatti International hospital and Ihsan Mumtaz hospital for prompt medical attention and care.

5. Mandatory hepatitis B Vaccination

Queens Medical College prioritizes the health and safety of its students. Hence, hepatitis B Vaccination is deemed mandatory for all enrolled students. The college will facilitate and ensure access to the vaccination process, ensuring compliance with this requirement.

6. Hepatitis B Antibody Test

In addition to mandatory vaccination, all students are required to undergo a hepatitis B antibody test to confirm immunity in case they have been previously vaccinated. This test is mandatory to ensure the health status and safety of the students and the community they serve.

7. Discount on Medical Services

Queens Medical College provide discount to their students on medical services. In outdoor patient services diagnostics have 50 % discount, Lab/Blood Tests at medical Laboratory have 50% discount and on medicines 30% discount can avail. Indoor patient services, have 100% discount, diagnostics have 50% discount, Lab/Blood tests at medical laboratory have 50% discount and on Medicine 30% can avail.



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8. Annual medical Examinations

Students should have their annual medical examination.

9. Compliance and Monitoring
